RESEARCH:

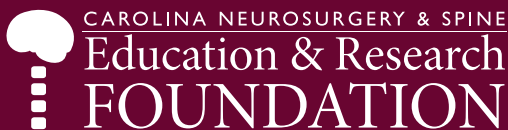
Funding will expand and support studies that will dramatically affect thousands of pediatric and adult patients with life threatening brain and spine injuries and diseases.

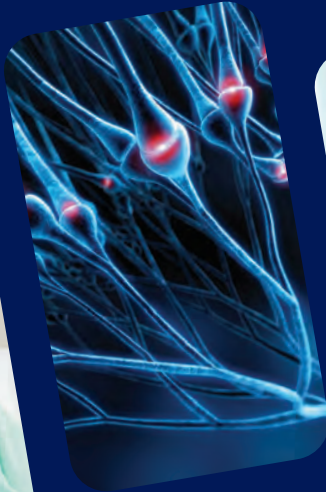
